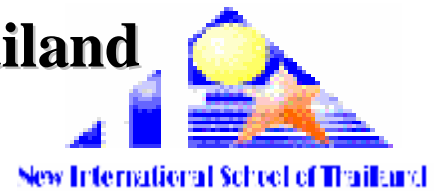

Description:

1st Phase of a multi phase development includes an Early Years Centre, A Sports Complex and Swimming Pool.

The Early Years Centre is designed to cater for the developmental needs of three to five year olds and contains specialized learning areas appropriate to students of this age.

The Sports Complex is designed to offer specialized teaching areas conducive to teaching physical education.

The rooftop with two tennis courts can be adapted to the needs of the physical education programme. The main upper floor is an air-conditioned multi purpose gymnasium, which can be divided into three teaching spaces with facilities able to cater for basketball, volleyball, indoor soccer and cricket and the wide variety of physical education requirements.

The lower floor will contain an aerobics centre, weights training and life skills (health) classrooms as well as changing facilities suitable to all programmes.

An eight-lane swimming pool is planned adjacent to the sports complex offering teaching facilities as well as opportunities for aquatic sports.

Technical Data:

Piling, structural and architectural works for Early Years Centre comprising 40 x 37m single storey building classroom complex. Sports Complex comprising 40 x 37m 3 storey building. New Swimming Pool 25 x 23m. Project includes building services under a nominated subcontractor. Contract included full air conditioning, electrical and mechanical installations. Total floor area of approximately 10,000 sq.m. All external works including roads, car parking, drainage and landscaping.
